Many will remember that the Victoria Bridge Club was located in Esquimalt when Bill took over in 2007 with his sister, Debbie Wastle, as business partner.

Bill's club continued to display the Unit trophies and memorabilia in addition to holding regular and mentor games both day and evening until it was forced to close during the COVID pandemic. During COVID, the club offered 2 online games per week on Bridge Base Online (BBO) which were well attended once players got the hang of it

In 2021, when face to face bridge was allowed again, Bill managed to secure some time slots for his games at the Strawberry Vale Community Hall but the dedicated club space was no longer available for Sunday mentor and special games, trophy displays and ACBL Unit 431 (Victoria and the Islands) board meetings. Adjustments have been required by us all but we have to thank Bill for getting some of our face-to-face games back!

In the early 2010's, as a result of Bill's introduction of the web movement (which ensures that all pairs play the same boards), the Unit 431 purchased a card sorter to reduce the effort required to duplicate the necessary game boards. Bill graciously offered his boards for the local tournaments put on by the Unit. Then came the purchase of the Bridgmate handheld scoring devices which has improved the timeliness and accuracy of the game results.
